

Minutes from PTO meeting on Sept. 22, 2009

Meeting called to order at 6 PM by Matt Fleece

Matt began by introducing himself to the attendees at the meeting. He stated he is “open to ideas” in regards to PTO and that people are needed to help with events.

The attendees were informed that Principle Woolston had provided the funds for the two open houses and that they were well attended.

Treasurer’s Report:

Teresa informed those attending the meeting that \$30,000 had been budgeted for the cookie dough sales. \$30,055 was made which will allow \$10,000 dollars to be divided equally between the teachers.

Further items covered in PTO meeting:

A mailing regarding the box tops will be sent out in October.

Shannon Shoots updated the attendees about the e scrip program. 10% of the proceeds from this go directly to Cromer school.

2 portable DVD players will be given away in a drawing during the Fall Craft Fair on November 7 for those names that have been entered with

their e scrip registration. Safeway on Highway 89 is the store that is currently working with Cromer on the e scrip program.

There will be a blood drive at Cromer school on October 6, 2009 from 1:30PM to 5:30 PM in the gym.

The updated budget for Cromer PTO was presented and accepted by those present.

It was discussed that during these uncertain economic times that the emphasis of funds the PTO provides for Cromer be directed in assisting the teacher directly in their classes. Be conservative in spending and fix up what we have currently.

Majority of funds provided for the Science Fair went to the purchasing of the display boards. Teresa mentioned another company that could provide the boards at a cheaper price.

Principle Woolston mentioned a Business Downtown Alliance. 10% of profits from local downtown businesses will go to Camp Colton. This will run for 2 months.

Numerous PTO activities need volunteers. (Cookie dough pick up, Trunk or Treat, Craft fair, 1st Cake Bingo, PTO family dinner night, 2nd cake bingo, Muffins with Mom, Donuts with Dad, End of year event.)

Each event has a folder with information to assist those volunteers for each individual event.

“Once is Enough” rule for teachers’ volunteering for events is being accepted.
