Tax Credit Donations

YOU HAVE A CHOICE!!! You can send all your tax dollars to Phoenix or have some of them used directly to improve education at Cromer.

For every dollar you donate to an eligible school activity, you will reduce your state tax bill by the same amount. If you have no bill, your refund will be higher by that amount.

There is no minimum to donate, only a maximum of \$200 for single taxpayers or \$400 for married couples filing jointly. **Any amount will help Cromer students!** Tax credit donations make possible a wide range of learning opportunities that our children would not otherwise have, like admission to parks, plays and museums, in addition to music, art and physical education programs.

You can choose which programs receive your funding, and can select as many as you want.

And the best part is... You don't have to have a child in the school district to benefit from this tax credit! Anyone who pays Arizona state taxes can make contributions to Cromer, including grandparents, aunts, uncles and friends.
